He astounded himself and was clearly delighted. He has improved on all 4 strokes over the year, his mark has been made on the 50m swims, following his late start into swimming, but his goals have been set for the coming year and he is even more determined to be successful to achieve more placing and more qualifying times. He is a delight to coach, and proves that no matter what age you start you can achieve, if you are prepared to put the work in. He has also improved his Fina Rankings 378-444 Fina Points in the 50 Fly.
